Last week, I published my Office Hours and I wanted to follow up to that. For the most part, I am going to be at the Church Office during those times. Obviously, if there is a pastoral emergency, I am dropping everything and going. I also want to be in the community if we are in the community doing something. For example, packing food bags every third Wednesday for the Ridge Springs area. If I know ahead of time if I am going to be somewhere specific, especially if it is during office hours, I will get it in the Eblast and encourage you to join me.

Since I have just started and am learning our weekly rhythm, the Office Hours will be a work in progress, and I may change them. The plan once I am a little more settled, is to use Monday and Tuesday afternoons to visit people, although it will not be limited to that. Thursdays are by appointment simply because I have two meetings that involve travel and take most of the day – one is a Clergy Group, and the other is Deep Roots in New Ministry (all of the new clergy in the diocese are strongly encouraged to participate). The other two Thursdays I will be around and more than likely in the office part of the day.

I am working with a couple of people on the Mission Council to figure out the best and most attractive way to have a sign or something indicating when I am not here. For now, perhaps the best way to check is to call before you come unless you are already in the Edgefield area.
