#### A word about our children and youth serving in church....

I am a huge fan of our children and youth participating and serving in church. I started at an early age singing in the Children's Choir and that is where I learned to appreciate our beautiful liturgy. I looked forward to the Sundays we would sing because it meant I had a front row seat to see what was going on up and around the altar. I also sang in the youth group choir, rang in the Bell Choir, and helped lead Children's Church, but by far my favorite thing was acolyting. It was a rite of passage in some ways to become an acolyte and once I was an acolyte, I wanted to stick with it and eventually become a crucifer and team captain. One of the crosses I wear, a Celtic cross, I received after being an acolyte from 7th –12th grade, upon my graduation from high school.

I loved acolyting because again, it gave me a front row seat to what was going on in the liturgy, but I also enjoyed working closely with my fellow acolytes, the clergy, and all those also serving on a Sunday morning. You will hear me say occasionally, I was trained by the best, the priest who was also in charge of Youth Ministry, Rev. Eric Kahl. As an assistant priest and then as rector of two different churches, he trained the acolytes, which is something I started while I was at St. James,

and I plan to continue at The Episcopal Church of the Ridge.

Acolyting may not be everyone's cup of tea, but there are other roles in which our youth and children can participate. Children and youth can pair with their parents to usher or greet and I have already seen this a little bit. Older children and youth can read either the lessons or the Prayers of the People. I would love to see more children and youth involved in our services.

It helps them learn our beautiful liturgy,


gives them a chance to take ownership in our service and have a leadership role, and gets them excited about coming to church and serving.
