

#### **Chrism Mass and Reaffirmation of Vows**

On Tuesday, I attended our Diocesan Chrism Mass and Reaffirmation of Vows at Trinity Cathedral in Columbia. It seems a weird time to have something like this in the midst of Holy Week when clergy are already busy preparing for all of the liturgies ahead in the next week. But the Chrism Mass has been celebrated during Holy Week since the early church. It is one of the most important liturgies of the liturgical year because it is when Bishops bless the Chrism oil, the oil we use at Baptism and the Oil of the Sick, which is used during prayers for the sick and healing services.

As important as it is for me to get our new Chrism oil and Oil of the Sick, it is also a time for me to be together with my fellow clergy colleagues and it is a time for all of us to be together with Bishop Richards. Our Bishop is both the Celebrant and the Preacher for the liturgy. We also all reaffirm our ordination vows, and even Bishop Richards reaffirms his ordination vows. We all vest and process and we are asked to wear the stoles we received at our ordination. Even though we are in that big space, it is an intimate time with our Bishop. It is mainly clergy, with a few spouses, and the Diocesan Staff attending. The sermon preached by our Bishop is for us. In this year's sermon Bishop Richards shared with us that he was honored to call all of us friends and that he loves us. It is also the one time a year that we are all together and so we have our annual picture made on the steps of Trinity

#### Cathedral.

And while it seems weird, it is just one more thing to add to an already busy week, and I sometimes question the early church and their decision to have it this week of all weeks. It is a nice break from all work and preparation. We also all have the chance to sit in the pews and worship and be fed by our Bishop. We also have the chance to fellowship and share a meal together and OK, maybe there is some commiserating as well. I am thankful to have such wonderful colleagues that I also call friends and a wonderful Bishop, that I also consider a friend.
