I have been thinking about this for quite a while and have asked around as well. I have even talked to Canon Rhoades about it in the past as we have been talking about and planning the service.

When I talked to Canon Rhoades about some last-minute details for next week, he had a wonderful suggestion. His suggestion was to bring over the Bishop's Chair from one church and

then have all the communion vessels come from the other church. The idea is that the area around the altar will be represented by all three churches. Larry and Ric brought over the Bishop's Chair from Our Saviour this week. On Sunday, Sarah and I will go through the communion vessels at Grace, so that I can bring them to Trinity.

An interesting note about the Bishop's Chair. Next Thursday evening, it will be front and center in the chancel. For Bishop Richards, there are only two times that the Bishop's Chair is brought to the center – for Ordinations and for Celebrations of New Ministry. So, this is something that is very special and rare for a parish to see.

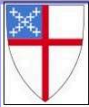
