A word about Father's Day...

Father's Day, just like Mother's Day, is one of those interesting days. Of course, it is important to celebrate our fathers. My dad died when I was a junior in high school. I have wonderful memories with him, but he also was not there to watch me graduate from high school or college, walk me down the aisle at my wedding. And perhaps the hardest thing of all, not around to share in my joy and make new memories at Sewanee while I was there in seminary. I was fortunate enough to have other father figures and eventually, Matt's dad, who especially once Matt died looked out after me and the house in which I was living.

Father's Day can come with all sorts of feelings, good and bad, happy and sad. There are so many cases where couples have decided not to have children or cannot have children or have lost children. Fathers who have watched their children go down destructive or unhealthy paths. There are children whose relationship is not great with their father, or they have lost their father unexpectedly or at an early age. But then there are those who are father figures and have stepped in when someone needed a father. Those who have become fathers, even when having biological children was not possible. There are those who have adopted entire families so that siblings would not be separated. There are those figures in our lives that have fathered us — taken care of us, upheld us, shaped, nurtured us into the people who we are, and our lives would not be the same without them. On Sunday, June 30th after the service at Trinity and before the potluck lunch, we will have a quick meeting to vote on updating the By-law regarding our annual audit. It will allow us more flexibility, particularly the ability to conduct our own audit, following guidelines and a checklist provided by our Diocesan Office.

The current by-law reads: All financial accounts of Episcopal Church of the Ridge shall be audited annually by a certified public accountant approved by the Mission Council.

The new by-law will read: All financial accounts of the Episcopal Church of the Ridge shall be audited annually in a manner approved by both the Diocese and the Mission Council.
