Studying the Saints

Our Monday Night Zoom Study Group starts again on September 21st. We will study the saints, focusing on American saints, although we will explore other saints as well. During the month, we will focus on the saints who are on the calendar for that month. Mother Lathrop will begin each night with some information from Lesser Feasts and Fasts and other resources. She encourages you to take the time and do some research on your own

and bring an interesting fact, something you didn't know about the person, a fascinating story or anything else you find out about the saint. The most up to date list of all the Lesser Feast and Fasts is found at Lesser Feasts and Fasts. All the major Saints, such as the disciples as well as major feast days, are listed in the monthly calendar: Liturgical Calendar for 2026. The beginning of the Book of Common Prayer in the Calendar of the Church Year section is also a good resource.

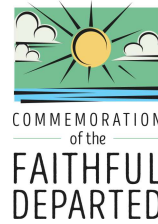

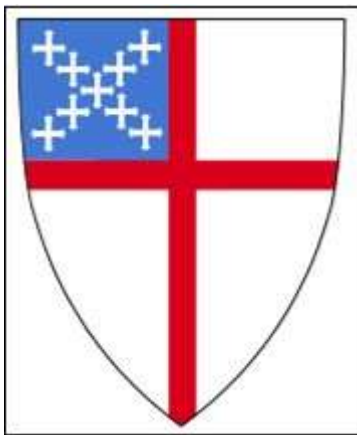
